

# Youth Career Experiences Program

## Objective

- The Career Experience Program is designed to assist participants in assessing their skills and experiences to identify a career goal.
- Provide participants with prior learning assessments and job shadowing experiences with qualified coordinators (employers).

## Eligible Participants

- Off-reserve Aboriginal community members of Brantford, Hamilton, St. Catharines, and Fort Erie
- Aboriginal includes First Nations, Status, Non-status, Métis, Inuit
- Between the ages of 15 - 30 (Inclusive) at time of intake/selection
- Individual will have completed a skills capacity inventory and resume for the Youth Services Officer (YSO) after assessment has been completed.

## Eligible Coordinators (Employers)

- Businesses
- Organizations

## Financial Assistance

- Coordinators who agree to provide job shadowing to a participant will be provided with a \$250.00 contribution by NPAAMB.
- Maximum assistance up to \$300.00 per participant.

**Restrictions:** Individuals may participate in the Career Experience Program on a one-time basis only.
